Since then, I have continued my running career and developed a passion for helping others who have ostomies return to an active and fulfilling lifestyle after surgery.

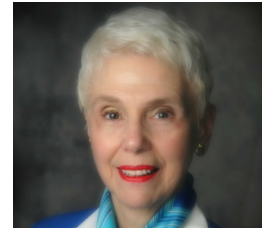
