(A healthy stoma should look red, moist, and shiny.)

Stoma Shape:

- Round
- Oval
- Irregular
- Smaller at the top, larger at the bottom
- Larger at the top, smaller at the bottom
- Has one opening
- Has two openings

Stoma Color:

- Red
- Pink
- Brown (not normal)
- Black (not normal)
- Maroon (not normal)
- Blue/Purple (not normal)
- Other

Stoma Position and Level:

- Below skin level (in a skin fold or sunken)
- Flush to skin level/at skin level
- Above skin level

Stoma Location:

- Right side above the belly button
- Right side below the belly button
- Left side above the belly button
- Left side below the belly button
- In or near a skin crease
- In or near a skin fold
- On a flat skin surface
